Dear Camper:

We are thrilled you will be joining us for an awesome week of fun, exploration, and friendship as we navigate our hearts to the Lord. Please be sure to read over the important rules and information and keep this packing check list handy as you prepare for camp in just a few weeks. (Please bring a trash bag for dirty clothes.)

Please bring a plain white t-shirt and a marker for signing the "camp shirts" of your fellow campers. Jr. and Sr. High campers may bring money for purchasing goodies at the snack shack and for crafts you may wish to do during afternoon recreation time. Those of you attending Children's Camp will have snacks and crafts provided, so leave your money home where it will be safe.

Please remember, Camp Bird has very strict rules about food and beverages not being anywhere on the grounds other than the mess hall and snack shack areas. DO NOT pack any snacks as they are not allowed in the cabin areas. This helps to keep the campground clean and the wild life in the woods. ALL CELL PHONES AND ELECTRONICS MUST BE TURNED IN ON ARRIVAL.

Packing List

- ___ sleeping bag/bedroll
- ___ pajamas
- ___ pillow/deodorant
- ___ soap/shampoo
- ___ brush/comb
- ___ toothpaste/toothbrush
- ___ bath towel & wash cloth
- ___ beach towel
- ___ flashlight
- ___ swim suit (One Piece, Modest)
- ___ insect repellent/ sunscreen
- ___ Bible/notebook/pen
- ___ plain white t-shirt if you want to participate in the signing
- ___ marker for signing camp shirts if you want to participate
- ___ plastic bag for dirty laundry
- ___ light jacket/sweater
- ___ extra pair of shoes and flip flop for showers (not just sandals, running shoes are required)
- ___ underwear/socks (for 5 days, bring extra)
- ___ adequate clothing changes for 5 days shirts/pants shorts (no higher than 3 inches from knee)
- ___ water bottle
- ___ Fan (box or oscillating)
- ___ snack money/camera (optional) (phones can not be used as cameras)

Camp Rules

1. Honor God in all we say and do. No swearing, rude or racial remarks
2. Respect all campers and leaders.
3. Respect all camp and personal property. No littering.
4. NO medications in cabins. ALL meds will be disbursed by the Camp RN
5. NO Food or beverages in the cabins!!
6. No boys allowed in girl's section. No girls in boy's section. No Youth in Children's cabins, no Children in Youth cabins.
7. Girls must wear modest 1-piece swimsuit; no bikinis allowed. Boys must wear modest swim trunks.
8. All clothing must be modest and without advertising alcohol, tobacco, secular bands, etc., or you will be asked to change.
9. No spaghetti strap tank tops or short shirts exposing the midriff. Shorts/Skirts MUST be no shorter than 4-5 inch inseam. If they are questionable you will not be allowed to wear them.
10. No low riding pants exposing under garments.
11. No walkmans, iPods, cell phones, Kindles, Nooks, tablets, pocket knives, weapons, music, toys, magazines/books, drugs, tobacco products, or alcohol allowed.
12. 1 stuffed animal or other comfort item is allowed.
13. Leaving the campground is prohibited.
14. Misconduct may result in restricted privileges or being sent home without a refund.
